

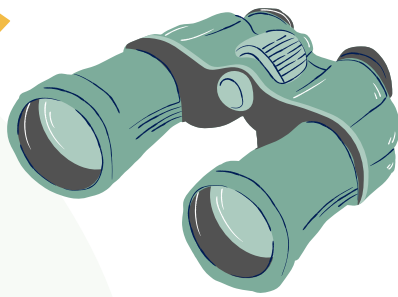

ASPiRES is a research-practice partnership between Ingham ISD and Michigan State University that uses data-informed approaches to support student career development programming.



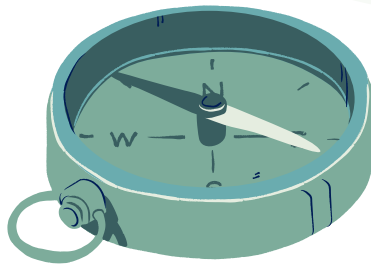
Our Goal

Ensure all students in Ingham ISD are able to develop the necessary knowledge and skills for success in a career of their choice and lifelong learning.

Research Aim 1

Identify students' career interests (using Xello/EDP data) and examine the alignment with market demands.

2 Research Aim

Develop research-based interventions to promote students' pursuit of careers that are aligned with market demands.



3 Research Aim

Identify new opportunities for supporting student career planning that complements and enhances current offerings.



4 Research Aim

Leverage career planning activities to increase student motivation and achievement.
